GAINESVILLE, Fla. – The Gainesville Roller Rebels (GRR) will take on the Tallahassee RollerGirls' Capital Punishment roller derby team on Saturday, July 21, at Skate Station Funworks. Currently ranked 10th in the South Central Region by the Women's Flat Track Derby Association (WFTDA), Tallahassee has been a force to reckon with this season. GRR is looking forward to what looks to be their toughest bout yet of the season, which began in February and runs through November.

While the competition is fierce on the track, off the track the two teams have a long history of helping each other out. Tallahassee hosted a boot camp for GRR back in 2008, when GRR was only a few months old. GRR will play the Tallahassee RollerGirls on Saturday, July 21, 2012, at Skate Station Funworks, 1311 N.W. 76th Blvd. Doors open at 7:30 p.m. and the bout starts at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$8 in advance at Skate Station, Sweet Dreams Ice Cream, Volta Coffee, and Brown Paper Tickets. Tickets are available at the door for \$12. Kids 12 and under get in free.
